HEALTHCARE

• *Support* legislation expanding access to affordable mental health services, medical care, and appropriately priced pharmaceuticals

EDUCATION

- *Support* major renovations to the community college finance system significantly improving our community college postsecondary completion and workforce development outcomes
- Oppose legislation negatively impacting the funding mechanisms for our public education systems

BUSINESS AND COMMUNITY ADVOCACY

- *Support* legislation recognizing the uniqueness of Texas businesses by delegating regulations to the appropriate level of government and creating fair and flexible options to avoid business restrictions and closures
- Support legislation clarifying that sales taxes in Texas be based on origin and not the destination
- Oppose attempts to standardize and oversimplify state or federal regulations weakening the Kilgore business community

ECONOMIC & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- Support efforts to expedite the rewrite of Chapter 313 economic development incentives
- Support legislation protecting the original intent of economic development funding for Type A and Type B purposes

INFRASTRUCTURE

- Support legislation improving access to quality water, broadband, electric, and gas services
- Support legislation protecting the rights of East Texans to maintain control of historical water rights
